

# University Requirements

To apply to an international university with your American high school diploma, you'll need to meet the specific admission requirements of the university, which often include official transcripts and proof of English proficiency. You should also check if you need to provide additional documents, such as SAT scores, AP scores, or translated and evaluated diplomas.

## 1. Research university-specific requirements

**Check official transcripts:** Make sure your school provides official high school transcripts with your diploma. Some universities may require you to have them sent directly from your school.

**Determine if you need SAT or AP scores:** Many international universities, such as NTU Singapore, require or strongly recommend AP scores in addition to your high school diploma.

**English proficiency:** Check if you need to take a standardized English proficiency test like TOEFL or IELTS.

**Translated and evaluated transcripts:** Some countries require you to have your transcripts officially translated into the local language and evaluated by an external organization to verify their equivalence to their own educational system.

## 2. Prepare your application documents

**Get official transcripts:** Request official copies of your transcripts from your high school to be sent to the university.

**Complete standardized tests:** If required, register for and take the SAT or AP exams.

**Submit language proficiency test scores:** If required, take the TOEFL or IELTS.

**Translate and evaluate your diploma:** Get your high school diploma and transcripts translated into the local language and evaluated by an official body if required.

**Create an account:** Create an account on the university's admissions portal.
